

INFORMATION ON THE 2027 NATIONAL ALVIS RALLY, BEECHWORTH VICTORIA SUNDAY 18TH APRIL TO FRIDAY 23RD APRIL, 2027

- The closing date for entries is November 30th, 2026 due to the need of the accommodation providers requiring final numbers by the beginning of January, 2027.
- The primary accommodation and all meals will be at The Grand Oaks Resort (in the grounds of the old asylum). The Grand Oaks Resort has 21 rooms, some of which can be converted into twin beds, should you advise us of the need. These rooms will be allocated on the basis of the order of entries being received. Further entries will be allocated rooms in the Linaker Art Deco Motel, which is in the same grounds and within walking distance of The Grand Oaks. There is ample parking adjacent to the accommodation and well away from prying eyes.
- Check in will be from 2.00 pm on Sunday 18th April, followed by a welcome barbecue at 6.00 pm. Drinks are available at bar prices.
- Breakfasts and evening meals will all be at The Grand Oaks. Breakfasts will be continental, with limited cooked choices and on alternate days full cooked breakfasts will be available to those who want it.
- All the runs have been organised and test driven. Monday 19th April will be a quiet day centred on the historic sights of Beechworth, to allow entrants to recharge their batteries after the drive to the rally. This will be followed by 3 days of longer driving, up to 200 km and broken into segments, taking entrants on good quiet picturesque country roads, through a mixture of high country and the upper reaches of the Murray River. Autumn colours will be spectacular and there will be interesting historic towns to explore. Two days will have catered lunches, whilst on the Monday and two other run days, entrants will self-cater for themselves, at towns which have plenty of choice of lunches and venues. The final day (Friday) will be a shorter run, so that entrants can rest in the afternoon, start packing, preparing for the final dinner and feel fresh for the commencement of the run home after the rally.
- The final rally dinner theme has still to be established and entrants will be advised in good time.
- Entrants should bring their own thermos, cups and tea/coffee making, so that they can stop at leisure, at a convenient spot on the runs, to enjoy a cuppa.
- We are very much looking forward to catching up with our Alvis friends, enjoying the camaraderie, the sight of a variety of cars and providing the entrants with a memorable rally.
